After five intensive class sessions and a thrilling round of "Arts/Client Speed Dating," BOARDway Bound then matches participants with a local arts organization for a multi-month observership. It's a great way to give board service a try!

**In its 12-year history, ArtsWave's BOARDway Bound has placed more than 300 volunteers on local arts boards.** Program alums remain involved through networking opportunities and events.

**Candidate Qualifications:** Applicants are accomplished, diverse and motivated professionals who wish to engage in leadership opportunities within the region's arts sector. Participants typically have minimal board experience yet desire professional development in governance best practices. All participants must commit to attending the sessions and completing assigned reading and exercises.

**About the Program:** The program is comprised of six sessions targeted to new board candidates and current board members seeking development training. The first session allows candidates to hear directly from arts organizations seeking new board members in an elevator speech marathon session. Sessions are conducted by local arts and business leaders, including ArtsWave President & CEO and veteran arts administrator, Alecia Kintner. In the final class, candidates will meet with their top 10 arts choices for board service in a fast-paced interview process.
